

Lisa Matassa

Lisa Matassa showcases a broad range of vocal abilities her new EP, *SOMEBODY'S BABY*, and hits all the right notes for fans of edgy, rockin' Country. With a voice that blends the soulfulness of Southern Gospel with a bit of "city polish" and a dose of Country/Rock flair, this EP is by far her best project yet. Produced by Tony Bruno (Rihanna, Enrique Iglesias), and recorded in Nashville and New York, the *It Is What It Is* Records / *Nine North Records* release features outstanding musicianship. The enhanced disc is comprised of seven songs and a bonus music video.



The New York songstress co-wrote three of the tracks ("Wouldn't You Like to Know," "Girl with a Rock 'n Roll Heart," "Learning as You Grow") and adds three stunning covers of hits made famous by Dolly Parton, Bryan Adams and Nat King Cole. The EP's first single is "Somebody's Baby," a new song written by hit-makers Kelly Archer, Casey Koesel and Justin Weaver. As a bonus, the song's dynamic and visually-enticing music video, directed by hotshot Traci Goudie (Hunter Hayes, Merle Haggard, Emmylou Harris, Patty Griffin), is included. The video debuted on AOL's *The Boot* on October 30 and has logged in over one million views.

Lisa is no stranger to Country audiences. This album is Lisa's third country-focused recording project, following last year's *ME TIME* and *SUNRISE HIGHWAY* released in early 2012. Her single, "Me Time," shot to number one on CMT's video charts shortly after its release, and her version of the revered standard, "The Christmas Song," also hit number one last December and remained in the top five on CMT's holiday chart during the entire Christmas season. She has opened shows for Dierks Bentley, Leann Rimes, Eric Church, Lee Brice and Ronnie Dunn. Operatically trained as a child and with a resonantly powerful pop voice, Lisa recorded two Top-10 Dance singles before she was 20. The songs were hits in the U.S. and abroad, earning her slots on the marquee with acts Taylor Dayne, Brenda K. Starr, TKA and others. Born on Long Island but raised in South Florida, Lisa grew up singing along to Patsy Cline, Loretta Lynn and Johnny Cash. Once she realized that Country music was her calling, she gave herself to it heart and soul.
